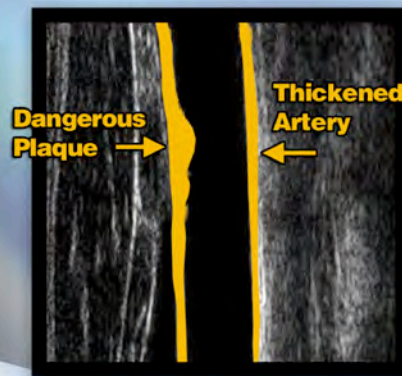

Atherosclerosis is the process that ultimately can lead to heart attacks and strokes. Using an easy, quick and painless ultrasound technique, the earliest signs of hidden plaque buildup (first seen as increased thickness of the artery wall) can be recognized. Much more sensitive than regular carotid ultrasound vascular imaging, this special technique, Carotid IMT, has been shown to correlate with future risk of stroke and heart attack.
